## V. New Business

- a. Question asked about pits- Do we need to ask for more? The precinct has been asked and has allowed us to use theirs. Cippi Palacios with Athletic Boosters would like to be asked to use his/theirs, but will allow its use for Invitational. There are 3 bags of charcoal left from last year. As of todays date, only one school has signed up for meal deals.
- b. Concession Stand- A game was added to Thursday night. Request for more volunteers to sign up to work. We did have \$842.00 in sales the first game.
- c. Trophy Sponsors- 4 for \$350.00 so far. Encourage any business owners to please sponsor. Trophy costs; A parent volunteered to make our trophies. - f. Kona Ice- He did show up to try out a Thursday night game. It was not profitable for him to come so no more Thursday night games.
- g. Meal Deal bags- a group of volunteers stayed last week to stuff bags. 500 were stuffed at the last meet. JP has meal deal boxes from last year that he will find and bring on over to band hall.
- h. Bags of ice- Approved to get a key and use freezer storage area at Junior High for ice, meat. Discussion of which ice machines we can use. FFA has coolers that we can use for ice. Idea given to fill the coolers with ice the night before Invitational.
- i. Randy has a Pizza guy to come to our next meeting to discuss how to set up, the cost/profit margin, etc. The pizza guy will be glad to donate monies as well; he can provide someone to man the tables too.
